

FLOORING Installation CHECKLIST

FLOORING XTRA

On the day of your installation, plan accordingly. Installation usually takes a day or less, but you won't be able to use the room(s) where the flooring is being installed for a period of time. With that in mind, reading over the items on this checklist will help everything go smoothly.

BEFORE INSTALLATION BEGINS, BE SURE THAT:

- There is a clear path for easy access to the installation area.
- Furniture has been removed from the room(s) receiving the new flooring. Alternatively, we may be able to move the furniture for you. Please ask us for more information if you are interested.
- Furniture and floors are covered as needed and breakables relocated.
- If flooring is being installed underneath appliances that need to be disconnected, plumbed or wired, arrange to have these removed. We can suggest tradespeople if required.
- Electricity and water are directly available in the work area.
- Any air vents in the installation area are covered to contain any dust.

DURING THE INSTALLATION:

On installation day, our installers will have all the equipment to install your new flooring. You won't need to provide any tools or materials. All we ask is that you:

- Keep children and pets away from the installation area.
- Have an adult with the authority to make installation decisions available at the property or by phone.

That's it! We'll take care of the rest. When the installation process is complete, our team will:

- Remove all installation related debris and dispose of your old carpet in an environmentally responsible way where possible.
- Conduct a final inspection of your new flooring.

AFTER THE INSTALLATION:

- Make sure all doors work properly - substantially thicker carpet may result in doors no longer swinging freely. A carpenter may need to trim these.
- Carefully move furniture and other items back into the room(s).
- Put appropriate protectors on the feet of chairs, tables and other furniture to avoid damaging your flooring.
- Immediately begin proper care and maintenance of your flooring. Always follow the manufacturer's recommendations to maintain your warranty and keep your new flooring looking its best.
- Put your Lifetime Installation Warranty in a safe place.
